


From Wise, VA to Lexington, KY - 175 miles

### Cost of Living and Safety

While located within driving distance of many metropolitan areas including the Tri-Cities of Northeast Tennessee (Bristol, Johnson City, and Kingsport, Tennessee), Roanoke, Virginia, and the Triad (Raleigh, Greensboro, and Winston-Salem, North Carolina), T&L employees enjoy a cost of living that is substantially lower than the national average including housing costs that are nearly 25% below the national average.
